

The Babinda Community Flow Chart



A guide for individuals working with people at risk of self harm and suicide

Questions to use to assess level of risk and to help decide where to refer

- Are there recent crises or stresses?
- Is despair/hopelessness being expressed by the person?
- Is the person receiving treatment for mental illness/emotional problem?
- Is there abuse of drugs or alcohol?

- Is there a family history of suicide?
- · Have there been past suicide attempts?
- Are they thinking about suicide?
- Have they a suicide plan?
- Do they have access to means (e.g. gun)?

Medium to High Risk

- Multiple risk factors present (consider answers to the above questions)
- Active suicidal thoughts present

Low Risk

Low Risk DOES NOT MEAN No Risk

Agreeable to a referral at next possible time
